Special Program at Troy University,

August 16 – October 8, 2021

English as a Second Language at Troy University will provide online classes to the support staff from Hungkuang University with the opportunity to learn beginners English. Participants will participate in our 8-week long online courses designed explicitly for them. They will have a weekly meeting with the instructor to review material and discuss ideas they did not understand. The classes will be taught using CANVAS. Details for login and ID will be sent to each student after registration.

Class Program

- **Listening/Speaking:** Students will learn techniques to help improve English-speaking skills such as pronunciation, listening for the main idea and details in a story, and English phrases and expressions.
- **Grammar/Writing:** Students will improve their English grammar through class instruction, exercises, and assignments; and writing short sentences about themselves, their work, and everyday activities.
- **Reading/Vocabulary** – Students will improve their vocabulary and basic reading skills through class activities, worksheets, assessments, and online activities through Quizlet and Kahoot.
- **Topics** – Students will learn through a variety of topics that include:
 - Greetings and introductions
 - Vocabulary for the office, school, and money/payments
 - Expressing feelings
 - Directions
 - Asking questions
 - Negative statements
 - American culture
 - Etc.

Activities and Extras

Beyond classes, participants will have the chance to practice what they have learned:

- **NEO Study app**
Students will have access to the NEO Study app, which will help them improve their speaking and listening English skills. The app included speech recognition, vocabulary, and listening practice.
- **Weekly Meetings**

Students will meet online with their instructor once a week to discuss the week's lessons, review any material they did not understand, and have discussions in English.

➤ **Kahoot and Quizlet**

Instructors will set up lessons and activities on the websites Kahoot and Quizlet. Both sites are designed to help students learn the material covered in class through games and activities.

When the program finishes, each individual who participates **and** passes the classes will receive a Certificate of Completion.
